A GUIDE TO THE LIBRARY AND
A LISTING OF BOOKS AND PERIODICALS RELATING TO
NEW ZEALAND AND THE PACIFIC ISLANDS

Introduction : Since April 2007 the books and journals owned by the New Zealand Society of Great Britain, and which previously formed its Library, have been on permanent loan to the National Philatelic Society (NPS). Those books and journals, and later additions, are now managed as part of the NPS Library at Freeling House, Phoenix Place, London WC1X 0DL. That building also houses the British Postal Museum and Archive (BPMA). A map showing the location of Freeling House is overleaf.

Using the Library : Members of the New Zealand Society of Great Britain are entitled to use the NPS Library on the same terms as NPS members and may consult, borrow and request copies of material in the Library.

Current issues of journals are available in the BPMA Reading Room, but other material is held behind the scenes. Books, and issues of journals since about 1990, are kept in a room in Freeling House to which only NPS officers have access. Retrieval of this material when NPS officers are available in the Reading Room – which is normally 11am to 3pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays – can take 30 minutes or more. Older journals, auction catalogues and other material are stored offsite, from where retrieval can take several weeks.

For practical purposes, therefore, members wishing to consult NPS material in the BPMA Reading Room, or to borrow material in person, should order their items well before a visit to Freeling House. Items can be ordered by post, by telephone on ☎ 020 7239 2571 (where messages can be left outside NPS duty times), and by e-mail to nps@ukphilately.org.uk/nps. Please state that you are a member of the New Zealand Society of Great Britain.

Items that members wish to borrow by post can be ordered in the same way. The NPS will send these with an invoice for postage and packing, and may use registered post for rare or valuable items. The initial loan period is 4 weeks, which can be extended at the discretion of NPS. It is the borrower's responsibility to return items in good condition at his or her expense with payment for the NPS invoice. Photocopies, within permitted limits, can be requested for delivery by post in the same way, when the invoice will include the NPS copying charges.

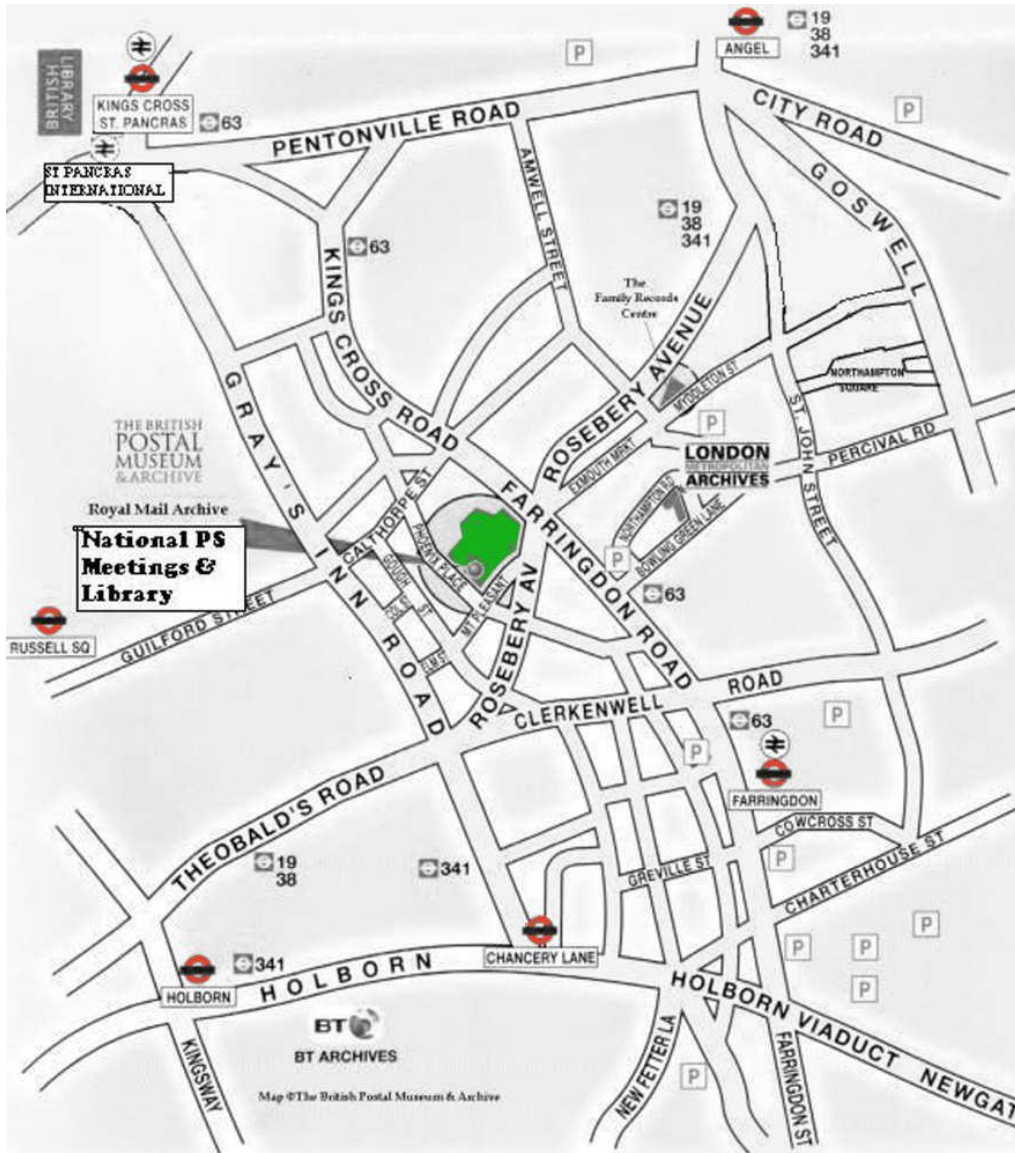

Title, plus	- any sub-title needed to clarify the subject matter - any comment needed to describe the document - in brackets, the publisher when this is a philatelic society or organisation
Author	- includes editor, compiler etc
Year of publication	- undated items appear first, but are not necessarily the oldest in any category
Number of pages	- to indicate each document's length : many modern books are A4 size, but older ones can vary considerably
NPS accession number	- this number, as well as title, author, year and publisher, can be used to interrogate the NPS online database - in numbers with more than 3 digits there is a space before the last 3 digits - accession numbers 4 5xx and 4 6xx indicate items on permanent loan from the NZSGB
